2010/11 Academic School Year Financial Aid Processing Timetable:

NOVEMBER 1, 2009	Financial Aid forms available. Families already receiving financial assistance will be mailed a SSS application. SSS website is available for parents to complete information online.
JANUARY 12, 2010	Deadline for submittal of PFS to SSS. If your taxes are not yet completed, enter your closest approximation using W-2s, 1099s, pay stubs, bank statements, etc.
JANUARY 26, 2010	Deadline for submittal of copies of filed 2008 Federal Income Tax Return (Form 1040), schedules, W-2's, 1099's to SSS. Incomplete files will delay consideration for financial aid.
FEBRUARY 25, 2010	Financial Aid decisions are mailed.
APRIL 1, 2010	Deadline for parental acceptance of the Financial Aid award offer. Enrollment contracts and required deposit must be submitted by this date.
